In 2018, the **Driver Alcohol Detection System for Safety Program (DADSS)** and **Virginia DMV** joined **James River Transportation** in a partnership to help end drunk driving on America's roads called **Driven to Protect**. Technology integrators installed prototypes of a breath alcohol detection sensor into Ford Flex vehicles in James River Transportation's commercial fleet.

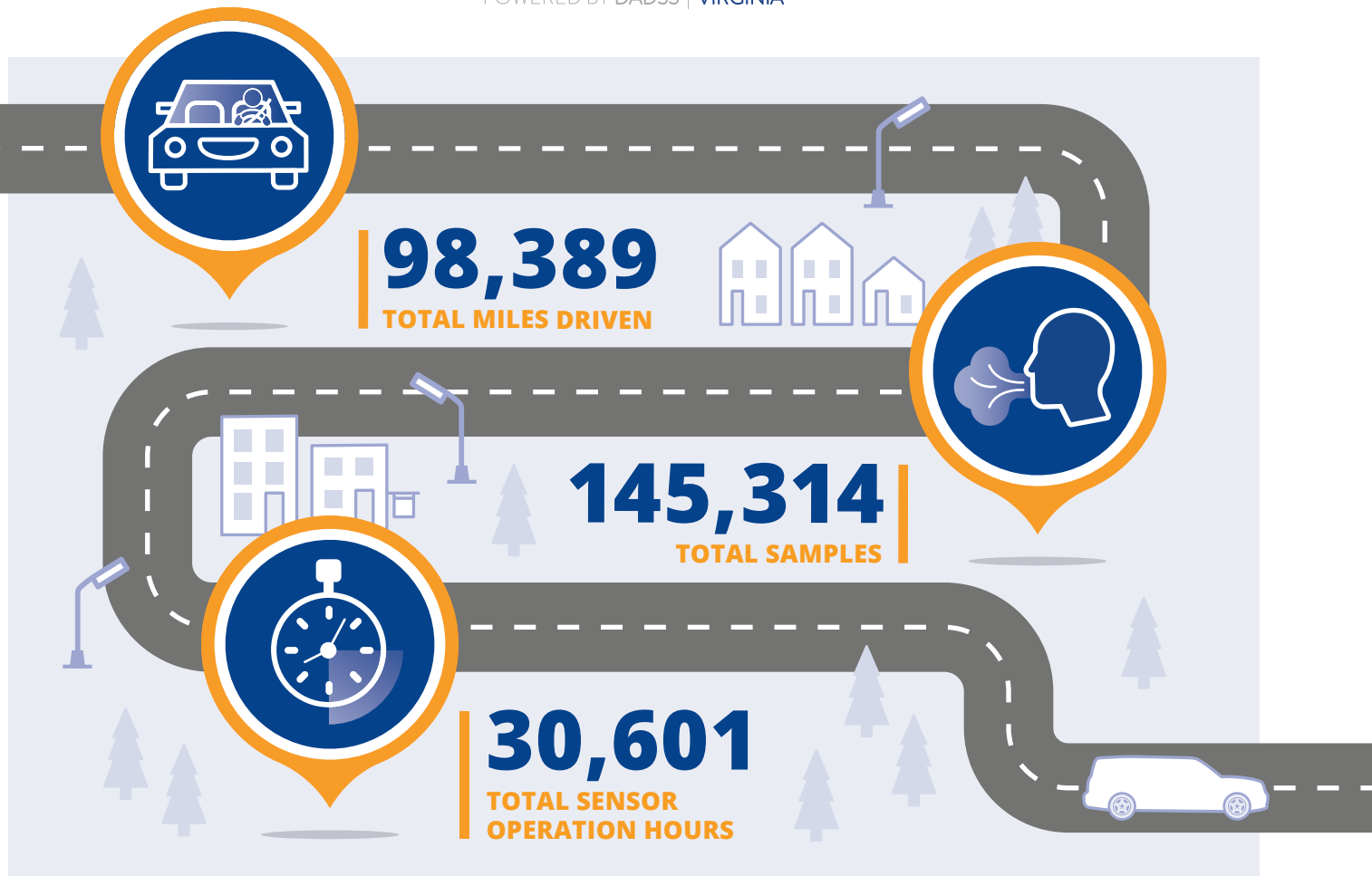
With every data point collected and every mile driven, the Driven to Protect partnership is bringing this **advanced safety feature** closer to availability in vehicles in America.
